



Attending a PREP CLASS, earns no classroom hours. Prep classes don't count towards any 60-hour pre-licensing or broker course hours. If needing to earn hours, take a "review class" for make-up hours, not a prep class. Prep is a part of our Plan2Pass!

- Make sure you are attending the right prep. A law prep – could be for MD, DC or VA.
- In person attendance receives printed materials at the start of the class.
Live stream/virtual attendance receives an email with attachments to print for at home use. Email will also include the link for Zoom attendance and is sent 24-48 hours prior.
- Completed payment is required prior to attending class or receiving materials.
- Do NOT record any of our sessions including tutoring. MD requires written permission to capture someone's voice and Plan2Pass does NOT grant permission to record classes.
- P2P provides our paid students with materials including audios usable by the student for a set period of time. Access to YouTube videos will also be granted for a set period.
- Do not distribute our materials – they're provided by Plan2Pass to prep class attendees.
- Prep class students may not recruit other attendees during the classes whether in person or in CHAT format. Sharing of personal information is not allowed within CHAT.
- Prep class students will not slander brokers, schools, programs or study options. We often provide an opportunity to recommend worthwhile study options and attendees are welcome to say they do not recommend an option but no negative remarks.
- You do not have to attend the full class since it does not count for hours, but an instructor will not be able to repeat the missed content during the class.
- Missing a portion of the scheduled class does not qualify for a refund. If you miss the class, you may request a credit to attend future prep. If you select the UNLIMITED prep option, then you are set to attend all scheduled prep classes for a 12-month period.
- If you are attending on Zoom, you will want to be able to see the presentation since we will often post practice test questions on the screen not included in your handouts.
- Disruptive, inappropriate, or unproductive conduct (that does not stop upon request) will allow for removal from in person or Zoom classroom. This includes anything visible on camera, background activity/noise and CHAT responses. Use mute responsibly.
