Program Enrollment doesn't obligate students to any affiliation or guarantee future affiliation or job placement. A graduation certificate will be issued once requirements have been met including 60 clock hours of attendance with 3 clock hours of Ethics, a minimum of 80% attendance for the 60 clock hours program and grades of at least 75% on the midterm and the final exam. Make-up policies require missed hours/work to be completed within 20 calendar days of program ending date. Required Dearborn Texts: (1) Modern Real Estate Practice 20th Edition (2) MD Real Estate Practice & Law 15th Edition. If the school closes or discontinues a program, the school shall refund to each currently enrolled student monies paid by the student for tuition and fees and monies for which the student is liable for tuition and fees. All fees paid by a student shall be refunded if the student chooses not to enroll in or to withdraw from a school within 7 calendar days after having signed a contract. If the student chooses not to enroll after the 7-day cancellation period but before the first day of instruction, the school may retain the registration fee. If, after the 7-day cancellation period expires, a student withdraws after instruction begins, refunds shall be based on the total contract price for the course or program and shall include all fees, except the registration fee and any charges for materials, supplies, or books which have been purchased by, and are the property of the student. The minimum refund that a school shall pay a student who withdraws or is terminated after the 7-day cancellation period has expired and after instruction has begun, is as follows:

The date of withdrawal or termination is the last date of attendance by the student. A refund due a student shall be based on the date of withdrawal or termination and paid within 60 days from the date of withdrawal or termination. Copy of Student Transcript will be provided upon student's request. Student advised to keep copies concerning enrollment and financial obligations. Enrollment is only binding if signed by applicant and school official. Modifications need student and school official initials.
